In terms of Sub-rule 3 of Rule 24 (A) of Mineral Concession Rules, 1960 read with clause 8 of sub-section (8-A) of section 8 of The Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Amendment Act, 2015, the lease of Jammu & Kashmir Minerals Limited granted vide Government Order No. 18-IND of 1989 dated 20-1-1989 for Sapphire and other Gem Stones such as Corundum, Ruby, Topaz, Garnet, Revellite and Aquamarine in Sumcham of Paddar area of District Kishtwar (erstwhile District Doda) is hereby renewed for a period of 25 years retrospectively with effect from 20-01-2009. This lease is subject to the following conditions:-

1. The Mining Plan will be got approved from the Competent Authority by the Jammu and Kashmir Minerals Limited within an period of two years in the first instance before exploitation of the deposits. For this purpose, JKML may conduct exploration for updation of data on reserves within the lease hold area.
2. The Environment Clearance and all other NOCs/NDCs as required under rules will also be obtained by Jammu & Kashmir Minerals Limited before exploitation of the deposits.
3. Jammu and Kashmir Minerals Limited will abide by all the terms and conditions as laid down in Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulations) Act, 1957 and the rules made there under.
