Subject: Regular Departmental Action against Sh. Prince Afroze Beigh, the then I/c DMO, Pulwama.

Government Order No : 226 -IND of 2018

Whereas, vide O. M No. GAD(Vig) 74-RDA/2016 dated 30.11.2016, the General Administration Department forwarded the communication No. 75/RC:0(A)05.CBI.ACB.SGR dated 6.09.2016 of Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) alongwith related documents, for initiating Regular Departmental Action (RDA) against Sh. Prince Afroz Beigh, the then I/c DMO, Pulwama, in accordance with the J&K Civil Services (Classification, Control & Appeal) Rules, 1956;

Whereas, the charge(s) framed against the delinquent officer by the CBI reveals that he had issued false & forged Royalty Clearance Certificate No. Pul/MS/DGM/290-92 dated 10.09.2011 in favour of Sh. Nazir Ahmad Khan Prop. M/s Irfan Khan, Tumna Chowkibal, Kupwara against lifting of 2322 Cum Sand from the sand extractors of District Pulwama. Based on the said Royal Clearance Certificate, final bill against supply of 2322 Cum Sand at Batpora Kupwara, under contract No.CDR 32 TF/01/2011-12 was released in favour of the contractor without going through the challans of sand extractors and hence caused loss to the state exchequer to the tune of Rs. 57502/-;

Whereas, vide Govt. Order No. 11-IND of 2017 dated 11.01.2017, the then Managing Director, J&K Minerals Limited, was appointed as Inquiry Officer to enquire into the misconduct against Sh. Prince Afroz Beigh, the then I/c DMO Pulwama;

Whereas, the Inquiry Officer submitted his findings/report on 19.01.2018 and recommending as under:-

"To take a lenient view by imposing a Minor penalty by way of affecting recovery from pay of the accused officer to the extent of shortages computed at Rs. 57,502/- imposed. Besides, the accused officer could be censured as envisaged under rule 30 of the J&K Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1956."

Whereas, the enquiry report alongwith the recommendations of the Inquiry Officer was placed before the Competent Authority, who accepted the same;

Whereas, the Director, Geology & Mining, vide letter No. IND/MNG/100/2016 dated 15.02.2018, was requested to recover an amount of Rs. 57,502/- from said officer besides serving a warning to him to remain careful in future;

Whereas, the Director, Geology and Mining vide letter No. 483-A/C-Adm/DGM/ER/16-17/RDA/487 dated 19.04.2018, informed that the amount of Rs. 57,502/- was recovered from the delinquent officer and the same deposited in Government Treasury under No. T. R. No. 7009 dated 13.03.2018 in the Additional Treasury, Tankipora, Srinagar;

Whereas, the recommendations of the Inquiry officer was forwarded to the General Administration Department vide letter dated 18.05.2018 for necessary action;

Whereas, the General Administration Department vide O. M. No. GAD(Vig)74-RDA/2016 dated 28.06.2018 advised to examine the Inquiry report and place it before the Competent Authority for decision on its closure or otherwise, and the enquiry be concluded through a speaking order; and

Whereas, the enquiry report was examined and it has been decided to impose a minor penalty upon Mr. Afroze Beigh, the then I/C DMO, Pulwama, in terms of Rule 30 of the J&K Civil Services (Classification, Control & Appeal) Rules, 1956 for the omissions and commissions committed by him, which has been approved by the Competent Authority;

Now, therefore, it is hereby ordered that one increment of Mr. Afroz Beigh, then I/C DMO, Pulwama (now I/C Assistant Mining Engineer), Geology and Mining Department, shall be kept withheld, in terms of Rule 30 of J&K Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1956 and warned to remain careful in future.


