In terms of Mines & Minerals (Development & Regulation) Act, 1957 read with Ministry of Mines GoI's Order S.O. 27(E) dated 04.01.2017 and Order No. 08/2018 dated 03.01.2018 passed by the Revisionary Authority, Ministry of Mines, GoI, sanction is hereby accorded to the grant of Mining Lease for extraction of Limestone in favour of M/s Khyber Cement Private Limited for captive purpose over an area of 126.43 hectares at Villages Kawarigam, Devipora, Chitisinghpora and Ranipora of Tehsil Shangus, District, Anantnag falling under the following Khasra No's and fulfilment of the conditions listed below:-

1. Director, Geology and Mining will execute the lease deed with the promoter only after completion of all formalities.
2. That no mining activity shall commence unless and until the applicant obtains Environment Clearance as laid down under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules made there-under.
3. That the area granted for lease shall be demarcated by the Directorate of Geology and Mining in consultation with the Revenue authorities.

4. That the lessee shall abide by the provisions of Mines and Minerals (Regulation and Development) Act, 1957 and the rules made thereunder from time to time.
5. That the lessee shall extract the limestone which shall be used for industrial use (cement plants).
6. That the mining lease shall be strictly governed by Rule 28 of Mineral Concession Rules, 1960.
7. That the lessee shall put under green cover the area which becomes available after excavation done up to road level.
8. That no digging or excavation shall be done below the level of the road.
9. That no quarrying shall take place in the forest area without obtaining authorization/NOC from the Forest Department.
10. That the lessee shall have no objection to the conducting of further investigations in the leased area by the Geology and Mining Department as and when required.
11. That the lessee shall not extract the limestone mineral from the area unless and until clearance under Air and Water is obtained from State Pollution Control Board.


