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Subject:- Accord of Administrative Approval to the "Development of Industrial Estate at Sahar Logate, Kathua".

Consequent upon decision of the Administrative Council, Administrative Approval is accorded to the "Development of Industrial Estate at Sahar Logate, Kathua" at a cost of Rs.63.30 crore (Rupees Sixty three crore & thirty lakh only) technically vetted by Development Commissioner (Works) PWD as per following breakup:-

The Accord of Administrative Approval is subject to the following conditions:-

1. That the project is structurally designed as per the latest relevant File No.IC-PLG/21/2021-02-Department of Industries & Commerce I.S Codes and specifications of PWD /CPWD and same is got authenticated and proof checked by the competent authority. While designing, latest HFL has to be taken into consideration for flood prone locations and adequate provisions in design need to be incorporated for making structures resistant to earthquakes.
2. Those Electrical/mechanical components are authenticated and technically vetted component Authorities of relevant field.
3. That the standard specification is followed as per CPWD, NBC and IS standards.
4. That the rates for the items, not covered in JK SSR or any other relevant schedule, shall conform to Analysis of rates based on authentic Data Book, to be computed and approved by the competent authority well before invitation of tenders in accordance with set codal procedures.
5. Electrical items are on the basis of vetting from Chief Engineer JPDCL (Distribution) Jammu.

6. Water supply items are on the basis of vetting from Chief Engineer (Public Health Engineering) Jammu.
7. The project shall be completed within the approved items as per the DPRs.
8. All the required codal formalities shall be fulfilled including the following of due e-tendering procedures.
9. The Administrative approval may not be treated as an authority;
 - i) to spend money not provided in the Budget and
 - ii) to create new posts, if any, provided in the AA.
10. The ban on the engagement of casual workers, need based workers etc. shall continue to be in force and the Department/Corporation shall refrain from making fresh engagements of any kind under the project.
11. The project shall be funded out of the Capex Budget of the Directorate of Industries & Commerce, Jammu from the year 2021- 22 and completed in maximum three years.


