Subject- GLOBAL INVITATION FOR REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP) FOR HIRING OF INTERNATIONAL RENOWNED CONSULTANCY FIRM FOR PROVIDING TRANSACTION ADVISORY, INVESTMENT PROMOTION FOR DEVELOPMENT OF THEME/AMUSEMENT PARK IN J&K- **Clarification thereof**

In reference to Tender ID 2023_IC_208207_1 bearing reference number IC-GEN/63/2023-02 dated 16.03.2023, following clarification is issued for perusal of all concerned:

1. **Mode of submission of Tender document fee :**

May please refer Note 3 in Point No 01-Fact sheet of the RFP. It clearly reads as "*Any payment to the Department by way of tender fee, EMD, and Performance Security may be by way of Insurance Surety Bond, Demand Draft, Fixed Deposit receipt, or Bank Guarantee*". Whatever be the mode of payment of Tender fee, it is non-refundable and as such has to be credited in the official account of the Department maintained by Director Finance.

2. **If the mode of submission of the Tender Document fee is a demand draft, then Demand Draft is to be drawn in favour of whom?**

The EMD as per RFP is to be pledged in the name of Director Finance, Industries & Commerce, Department, J&K. Accordingly any payment, including Tender Fees, shall be in the name of Director Finance, Industries & Commerce, Department, J&K.

3. **If the mode of submission of tender document fee is online payment, then NEFT form would be required.**

Please refer to clarification to Point 1.



4. **Also it has mentioned in the RFP that the demand draft towards the Earnest Money Deposit should be submitted online. Are they expecting bidders to send the original DD to them and upload a scan copy in the E-portal which is not clear?**

The Bidders have to send the original Demand Draft or short-term/fixed deposit duly pledged to Director Finance, Industries & Commerce Department, J&K. A scanned copy of the same would need to be uploaded on E-portal while submitting bids.
