Subject:-Procedure for grant of Central Capital Investment Subsidy to Eco-tourism units.

Government Order No. ¹⁵⁵IND of 2017
Dated. 16 -06-2017

In Partial modification to Government Order No.80 IND of 2006 Dated 23-03-2006, the annexure to the Order at 2(b,e&f) shall be read as:

- (b) The existing eco-tourism units desiring to undergo Substantial Expansion shall submit a detailed project report with the prior approval of Director tourism concerned. The project report shall be got prepared by a Consultant/Firm/Company/Architect duly approved by Director Tourism Concerned. The eco-tourism unit shall also get detailed Project reports prepared from the approved Consultant/Firm/Company/architect. The Director tourism concerned after scrutiny of the claim and satisfying himself about the genuineness of the claim with regard to the Plant and Machinery, shall assess the amount on which 15% CIS is payable and recommend the case to the Administrative Secretary Tourism Department along with the following documents:-
- Certificate from the Chartered Accountant that the expenditure has been actually made by the unit holder on the project.
 - Certificate in case of civil works, electrification and sanitary fittings etc.
 - Following officers shall issue certificates as per format used in disbursement of CIS to industrial units:

1) Civil works up to value of Rs.50.00 lacs	Dy. Director Tourism, M&W Jammu/Kashmir
2) Civil works above the value of Rs.50.00 lacs	Chief Engineer, (R&B) of the area concerned. In case of Leh & Kargil Districts , the District Superintending Engineer PWD (R&B) who enjoys the powers of Chief Engineer will be the prescribed authority for recording the certificate.

- Certificate from the Director Tourism concerned that the Plant and Machinery as per vouchers has been purchased and installed on spot and it is also as per requirement of the concerned Eco-tourism units.
- The quantum of subsidy of the equipment plant and machinery shall be determined on the production of bills/vouchers/GRs/TT receipts/payees receipts in original

issued by approved dealers within or outside the State and mode of payment certificate from a Chartered Accountant

- (c) The Director Finance or FA/CAO of Administrative Department Tourism will recommend /certify that all the documents required for sanctioning the case are complete in all respect through the Administrative Secretary.
- (d) The approval of the case shall be done in the meeting of State Level Committee-I (SLC-I) constituted for this purpose. Director tourism Jammu and Director Tourism Kashmir Concerned shall be the Member Secretary for the State level Committee-I (SLC-I) meetings in which exclusively the case of eco-tourism units shall be considered. He will prepare and circulate the agenda to the State Level Committee for their approval, along with his specific recommendations.
