Sanction is hereby accorded to the constitution of a team of following officers;-

The above team shall inspect the following units

Phase Ist, Khonmoh, Srinagar.

The team shall examine the following details with respect to the above mentioned units:-

- i. Activity for which these units were registered;
- ii. Machinery/equipments installed, with their capacity to produce/manufacture and power consumption;
- iii. Quantity of raw material consumed per day / per month, Electricity bills for last twelve months and whether they commensurate with the machinery installed;
- iv. Assessment for raw material made by the concerned GM, DIC since DOP of these units ;

- v. Sales Tax payments receipts;
- vi. Pollution Control Clearance/Pollution Control devices installed;
- vii. Details of invoices of the raw material used by these units; and
- viii. Address of the firm (s) providing raw material to the units with contact details.

The detailed verification report submitted by the inspection team must include the following:-

- a) Whether claims/counter claims made by the petitioner/caveator before the Hon'ble High Court are genuine and based on facts ;
- b) Whether claims of petitioner/caveator are genuine in the light of existing Industrial Policy and Acts/Rules governing the subject; and
- c) Whether petitioner/caveator are indulging into any kind of bye-passing rules/statutes for undue benefit, causing loss to State Exchequer.

The above team shall furnish its report by or before 7th of July, 2017 positively.


