Order No. 271-Ind of 2017, sanction is hereby accorded to the release and advance drawal of funds amounting to Rs.523.11 Lakh (Rupees Five Crore Twenty-three Lakh Eleven thousand) only for implementation of projects out of the funds revalidated by Planning Development and Monitoring Department under Prime Minister's Development Package (PMDP) during the current financial year 2017-18 in favour of Director Finance, Industries and Commerce Department for its further placement at the disposal of the Managing Director, J&K SICOP Ltd. as per the breakup given below:

The release / advance drawal is subject to the following conditions:-

- 1.The expenditure shall be booked strictly against those projects / works submitted under PMDP Package.
- 2.The Managing Director, J&K SICOP Ltd. shall satisfy himself about the reasonability of costs, proper quality control and, genuineness of work done claims.
- 3.The funds released shall be utilized for the specified purpose after completing all codal formalities/ procedures as required under rules and shall not be available for re-appropriation/diversion at any level
- 4.The Managing Director, J&K SICOP Ltd. shall ensure that all identified projects/works be completed within the approved cost and no liability shall be created in any case.
- 5.There shall be no overlapping of funding from any other source such as CSS/Flagship programme/Capex Budget or any other source of funding.
- 6.The Managing director shall ensure that the advanced money is not blocked and kept in the bank account unnecessarily.
- 7.Utilization Certificate shall be submitted to the Administrative Department and Principal Accountant General J&K after incurring the expenditure.
- 8.Managing Director, J&K SICOP Ltd. shall vouch safe availability/ utilization of funds.
- 9.The funds shall not be available for payment on account of contingencies and cost escalations at any level.

The expenditure shall be debit able to the Object Heads:-

- a. Major Head = 4852 -Capital Outlay on Iron & Steel Industries
- b. Sub-Major Head = 02—Manufacture
- c. Minor Head = 190—Investment in Public Sector & other Undertakings.
- d. Group Head = 0011- State Plan normal
- e. Sub-Head = 1224- SICOP.
- f. Detailed Head = 400-Plan Assistance
