Sanction is hereby accorded to the deputation of Shri Mushtaq Ahmad Bhat, Assistant Executive Engineer (Civil), JK Cements Ltd. to J&K State Industrial Development Corporation (SIDCO) for a period of two years subject to the following terms and conditions of deputation:-

- i- The salary of the employee shall be drawn as per the LPC issued by JK Cements Ltd. without deputation allowance.
- ii. COLA shall be paid at the rates as is being paid to him and the subsequent release of COLA shall be applicable to him as and when the same is released by the JK Cements Ltd.
- iii. No arrears on account of pay or COLA shall be paid in favour of the official by the Government;
- iv. The salary in favour of the employee shall be released from the date he joins his duties in the J&K State Industrial Development Corporation (SIDCO);
- v. The post vacated by the employee in the JK Cements Ltd. shall be deemed to have been frozen and shall not be filled up either by promotion or by direct recruitment;
- vi. The above arrangement shall be reversible without any notice; and
- vii. The official shall retain his lien in the parent organization.
