The terms of reference of the sub-committee shall be as under:

- i. Examine and evaluate the revalidation proposal of cases placed before 47th APCC for recommendation and resubmission to APCC on case to case basis.
- ii. Assess the performance of the units on the basis of milestones like timeline and investment made by the promoter towards the establishment of unit.
- iii. Scrutinize the revalidation proposal in the context of the financial loss to the government and to the Corporations by way of premium loss, if such proposals are submitted /renewed after reasonable period of time.
- iv. See whether there is abnormal lead period for the investments to be made from the date of initial registration and the objectives of the employment generation not achieved due to abnormal lead period.
- v. See whether land allotted is compatible and commensurate with the investment and employment generation.


