Sanction is hereby accorded to the advance drawal of funds amounting to Rs.100.00 Lakh (Rupees one crore) only under Capex Budget 2022-23 by Director, Handicrafts & Handloom, Kashmir for **procurement of Optical Fiber Diameter Analyzer (OFDA)** out of the funds available with the Directorate under the scheme "Up-gradation lab facility at IICT & PTQCC".

The sanction is subject to the following conditions:-

1. Dy. Director (Planning)/ Chief Accounts Officer Directorate of Handicrafts & Handloom, Kashmir shall vouch safe availability of funds in the Capex Budget 2022-23.
2. The expenditure shall be incurred after fulfillment of all requisite codal formalities as prescribed under GFR & after following due e-tendering procedures.
3. The expenditure shall be booked on approved items and with approval of the competent authority.
4. Detailed Red DC account of the advance drawal shall be furnished to all the concerned quarters within stipulated time but before 31.03.2023.
5. Requisite utilization certificates shall be submitted to the concerned quarters with a copy to the Administrative Department within stipulated time period.
6. The funds shall not be available for diversion/re-appropriation at any level.
