1. That the work shall be executed only after completion of all codal procedures/formalities strictly in accordance with the standing norms/orders/guidelines/instructions issued by the Government from time to time.
2. That the work shall be executed as per the approved specifications/designs/norms strictly as per the detailed estimates and requirements by utilizing quality raw material.
3. That the work shall be completed within the AA to the utmost satisfaction to the intending department and the expenditure shall be incurred strictly as per AA/technical sanction accorded by the competent authority. No liability whatsoever shall be allowed/entertained that there is no overlapping of funding from any other scheme/source/project



4. That the executing agency shall maintain and produce the pre, during and post execution photographs of the work along with the latitude-longitude coordinates of the project location.
5. That the work shall be completed in all respects within the specified time frame and no cost overrun/escalation shall be entertained.
6. That the work shall be executed strictly as per the cost estimates and specific drawings approved by the competent authority and no deviation shall be made in the drawing/designs/specifications of the works without prior approval.
7. That no further revision in the cost in respect of each component of work/construction shall be allowed and work shall be completed within the estimated cost and specified period as per the technical sanction of the competent authority.
8. That the project shall be funded under Languishing Projects.
