Subject: - Repatriation of Mr. Altaf Hussain Ganoo, Class –IV (Token No. 1261).

**Government Order No. 67 -JK (IND) of 2022
Dated: // .04.2022**

Mr. Altaf Hussain Gano, Class-IV (Token No. 1261) of JKCL, presently on deployment to J&K SICOP, is hereby recalled and his services are placed at the disposal of Directorate of Industries and Commerce Department, Jammu on deputation basis against the post commensurate to his pay scale for a period of one year or till the post is filled up on regular basis or till the official is recalled, or retired, whichever is earlier, subject to the following terms and conditions:

- i. The salary of the official shall be drawn by the Department/Organization/Corporation against the available vacant post as per the LPC issued by the J&K SICOP and without any deputation/deployment allowance.
- ii. COLA/DA shall be paid at the rates, as was being paid to him/her and the subsequent release of COLA/DA shall be applicable to him/her as and when the same is released by his concerned Corporation.
- iii. No arrears on account of pay or COLA/DA shall be paid in favour of the official.
- iv. He shall retain his lien, seniority and promotion prospects at his parent Corporation viz. JK Cements Limited.
- v. The official shall remain on the rolls of J&K Cements Limited and shall not opt for the Golden Handshake Scheme which shall be certified by the concerned Organization.
- vi. The above arrangement shall be reversible without any notice;
- vii. The post vacated by the official in J&K Cements Limited shall be deemed to have been frozen and shall not be filled up by promotion or by direct recruitment.
- viii. The official so deployed shall furnish an undertaking duly attested by the 1st Class Magistrate stating therein that he has no right to claim for permanent absorption in the department and will not approach any Hon'ble Court of Law for the said purpose.
- ix. The Pay level and designation shall not be taken as authentic and shall be subject to further verification by Managing Director JK Cements Limited /J&K SICOP in his LPCs to be issued by the concerned HoD.
