The Accord of Administrative Approval is subject to the following conditions:-

1. That the proposals are strictly devised and designed as per latest relevant I.S & International codes and specifications and same is authenticated and proof checked by the competent authority (J&K Fire Services). While designing, all safety factors, governing the field as per international standards, are followed and adopted.
2. That the lump-sum provisions, either in terms of percentage or fixed as made for certain components of the DPR are provisional and shall be subject to detailed estimates based on actual design details/requirements and relevant rates, to be framed and approved by competent authorities well before invitation of tenders in accordance with set codal procedures.
3. That e-tendering mode is followed for fixation of the award of contract for execution of the project. Fragmentation of project, while tendering, is not allowed.
4. The Technical Vetting is exclusively for the purpose of Accord of Administrative Approval and shall not be construed as any rate approval to the project or any approval for inclusion in the plan.
