Subject: Repatriation of employees of JKCL from Geology and Mining Department and further deployment thereof.

Government Order No. 134 -JK(IND) of 2023
Dated:- 09 .06.2023

Sanction is hereby accorded to the repatriation of following employees of J&K Cements Limited from Geology and Mining Department and their further deployment to Directorate of Industries and Commerce Kashmir, initially for a period of two years, against the vacant posts commensurate to their pay scales/levels, as identified by the Directorate of I&C Kashmir and communicated vide letter No: DI&C/Estt/C-481-II/1371 dated: 10.05.2023:-

The deployment of above officials to the Directorate of Industries and Commerce, Kashmir shall be subject to the following terms and conditions:-

1. The salary of the officials shall be drawn by the Department against the available vacant post commensurate to their pay scale as per the LPC issued and without any deputation/deployment allowance.
2. COLA/DA shall be paid at the rates, as was being paid to him and the subsequent release of COLA/DA shall be applicable to him as and when the same is released by the concerned Corporation.
3. No arrears on account of pay or COLA/DA shall be paid in favour of the officials.
4. The salary shall be released in favour of the official from the date he join his duties.
5. He shall retain his lien, seniority and promotion prospects at his parent Corporation viz. JK Cements Limited.
6. The official shall remain on the rolls of J&K Cements Limited and shall not opt for the Golden Handshake Scheme which shall be certified by the concerned Organization.
7. The above arrangement shall be reversible without any notice.
8. The post vacated by the official in J&K J&K Cements Limited shall be deemed to have been frozen and shall not be filled up by promotion or by direct recruitment.



9. The official so deployed shall furnish an undertaking duly attested by the 1st Class Magistrate stating therein that he/she has no right to claim for permanent absorption in the department/Corporation and will not approach any Hon'ble Court of Law for the said purpose.
10. The Pay level and designation shall not be taken as authentic and shall be subject to further verification.
